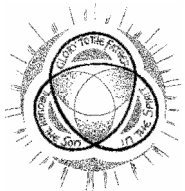


The Most Holy Trinity

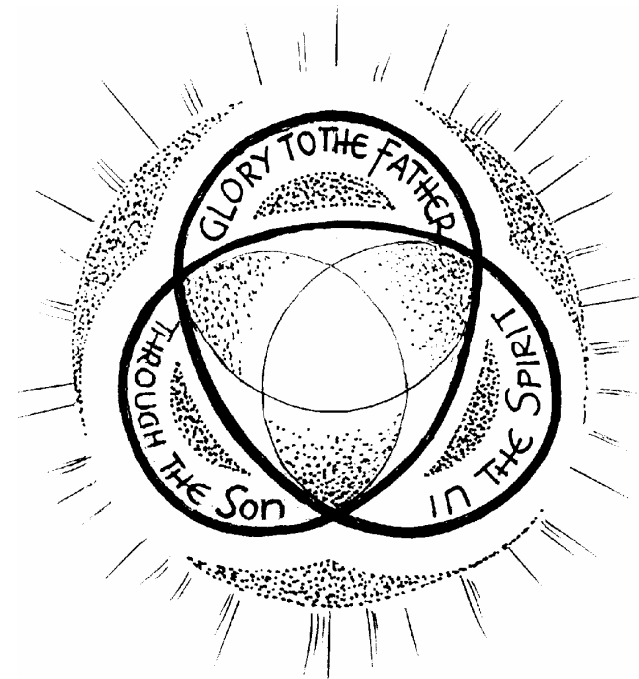
