He was tough - he could face anything. And he never lost trust in God, or in people. He never lost hope; he never gave in. He never stopped loving.

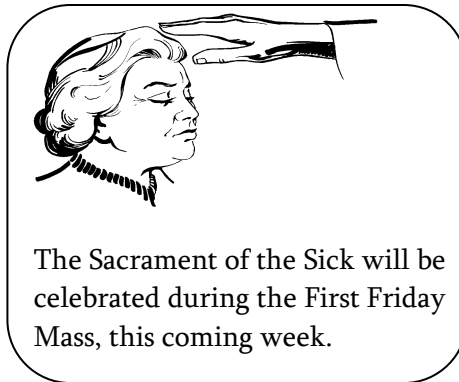
