## **Mission Sunday**

Last year the sum of €37,400 was raised on Mission Sunday in the Achonry diocese for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, an increase of 9% on the previous year. In 2006 Ireland was ranked seventh in the world in total funds raised for the Society. Some €15.7 million has been raised in Ireland through the Mission Sunday collection since the year 2000. Mission Sunday will be celebrated this year on 21st October.

In October 2002 Pope John Paul II added the five Mysteries of Light to the Joyful, Sorrowful & Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary. He singled out five significant moments in the public life of Christ for our reflection as we recite the Rosary on Thursdays.

1. Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan.
2. The Wedding feast of Cana.
3. The proclamation of the Kingdom.
4. The Transfiguration.
5. The institution of the Eucharist.

These new mysteries are meant to give the Rosary fresh life & to kindle renewed interest in the Rosary's place in the lives of today's Christians.
