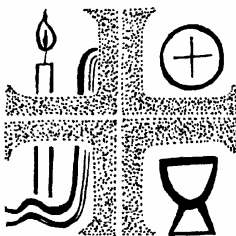
Liturgy Workshop

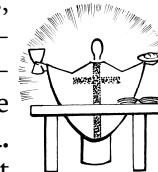
