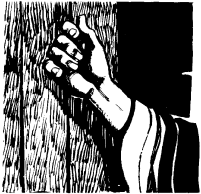


God's Call

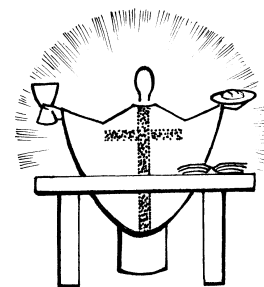
