On the education front Kairos works closely with St Patrick's College, & National University of Ireland, Maynooth. Courses offered include, Diploma in Communications, Postgraduate Diploma in Christian Communication & Development, BA in media studies, MA in Radio & Television Production.

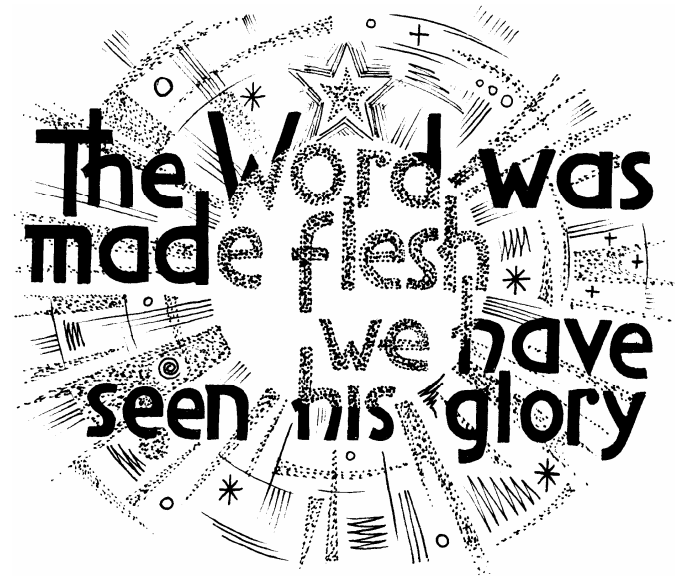
