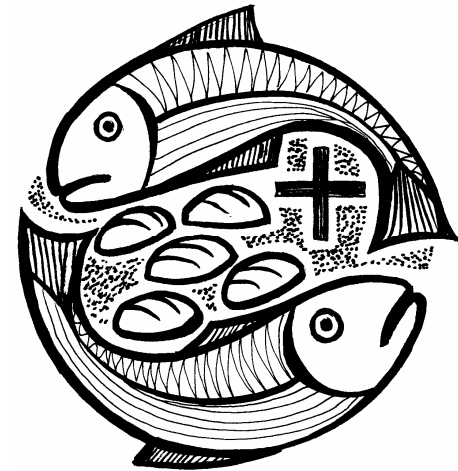

**School Improvements**

Attymass N.S. has been  
successful in obtaining two  
substantial grants from the  
Department of Education to  
enable necessary  
improvements to be carried out  
during the summer.

A **90% Grant** for an entirely  
new heating system has been  
obtained. It will replace one  
that has served the school for  
30 years. In addition, the  
school has applied successfully  
for a **100% Grant** for the  
insulation of the roof and walls  
of the building. This should  
help to reduce the cost of the  
oil-fired central heating.
