a God who is love.

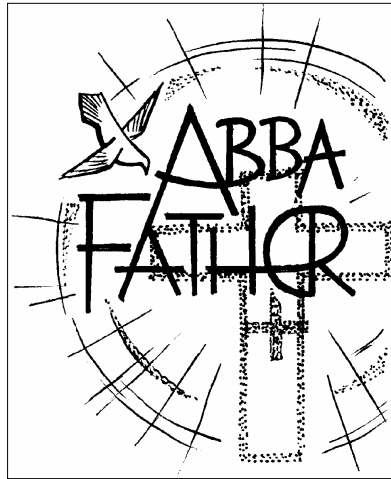
A God who is Father,
