The God of the lowly valleys.

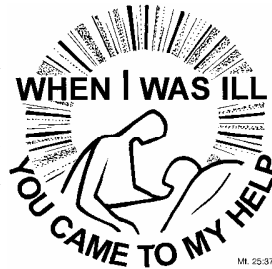
He inspires all things,
