Tuesday Card Game

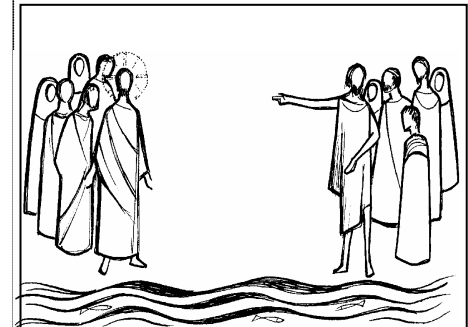
The card games in the Community Centre continue on **Tuesday next 20th January** at 9.00pm. All are welcome.
