Offertory Envelopes for the coming year are available in the church porch this weekend. Newcomers & others who wish to have a box of envelopes are requested to contact the parish priest.

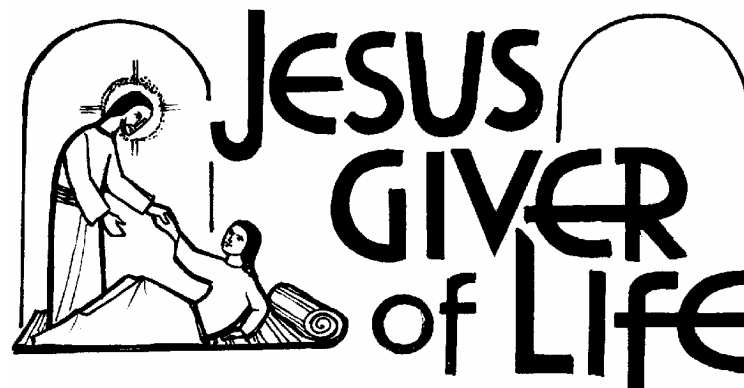
