Lenten contributions to Trócaire from our parish now amount to **€2,364.50**. Thanks to all who remembered the poor of the 3rd World during Lent.

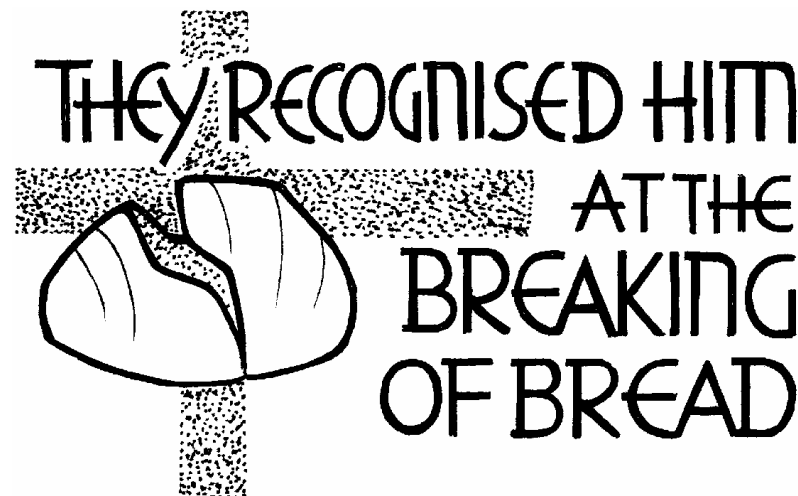
