Christians so often think they must always contribute something when they are in the company of others, that this is the one service they have to render. They forget that listening can be greater service than speaking.

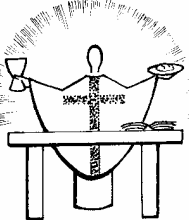
Many people are looking for an ear that will listen. They do not find it among some people because these are talking when they should be listening.

**“Do this In Memory”**

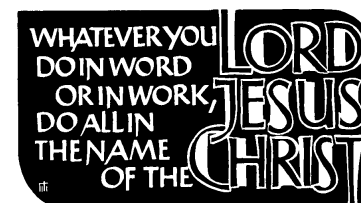
The above programme for children preparing for First Penance, First Eucharist continues on **Sunday next 19th October**.
