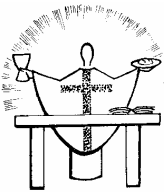

All Masses will be celebrated in the Oratory of the Fr Peyton Centre at 8pm.

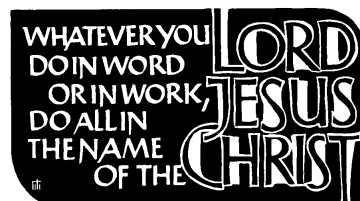


Old Killeen Committee

**Questions People
Ask**

Q. *How might I answer my friend who insists that we should base our religion on God's word in the Bible rather than Church doctrines?*

A. It is not a case of bible against Church. The Bible is part of the Church's heritage. The oldest document in the New Testament is 1 Thessalonians, used in this Sunday's Mass. Notice how Paul praises the faith, love and hope which the Thessalonians had even before any of the New Testament was written. The believing community, that is, the Church, existed before any of the book was written. The Christian Church, under God's inspiration, produced the writings of the New Testament. The book is part of the Church's heritage.
