parishioner.

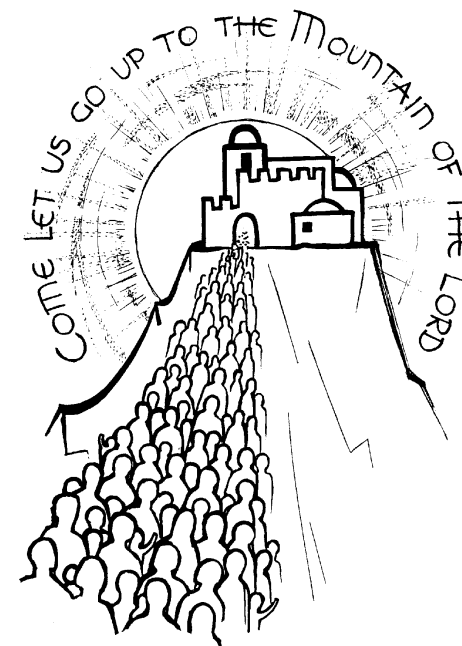
