Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will from now on be held every Friday 6.20-7.20pm.

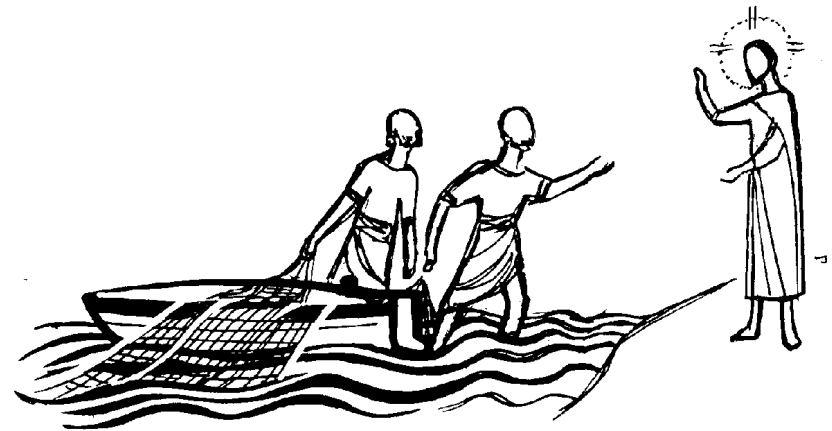

Parish of Ballaghaderreen

(As we pray the Diocesan Prayer each day this coming week we are asked to remember especially the parish of Ballaghaderreen.)

The parish of Ballaghaderreen is the Cathedral parish of the diocese of Achonry. There are four churches in the parish, each with its own vibrant community, Ballaghaderreen, Brusna, Derrinacantha and Monasteraden.

The Cathedral was consecrated and dedicated to St. Nathy and the Annunciation on the 3rd. November 1861. The Church of St. John the Baptist and St. Colman in Derrinacantha was built in 1873, & St. Aiden's, Monasteraden was built in 1881. The church of the Sacred Heart, Brusna was opened 1950.

Three counties meet in the parish, Sligo, Mayo and Roscommon.

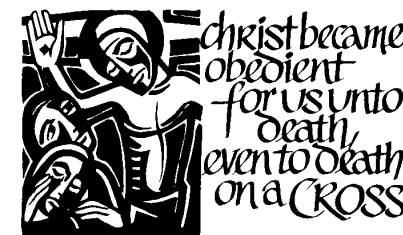
Moy Villa New Officers
