Emigrant Collection

A collection in aid services for Irish Emigrants will taken up on St Patrick's Day.

Funds raised through this collection will be used to support the work of the Catholic Church's Emigrant Council and other projects that provide pastoral care to marginalised and

vulnerable Emigrants.

In 2013 the Council awarded grants to the Irish Chaplaincy in Britain, the Irish Pastoral Centre in Boston, the Irish Apostolate USA and the Aisling Return to Ireland Project. These grants were essential in allowing these organizations to provide essential guidance and support to young Irish immigrants who require assistance with visas, housing, and employment. Without support from the Pastoral Centre, recent immigrants may be unaware of their visa options and may become undocumented."
