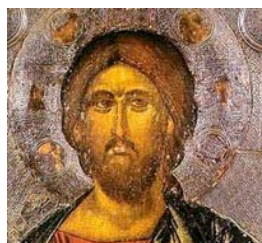

Community Centre Grant

A Leader Grant of €177,350.00 has been authorised for the renovation & extension of Attymass Community Centre (Old School). The local contribution/match funding is €67,229.00 of which €55,000.00 is the donation of the leased property. The balance of the local contribution amounts to €12,229.00.

The contractor is **Brendan Henry**, Carrowmorris Developments Ltd, Culleens, Co. Sligo. It is expected that work will begin in the near future.

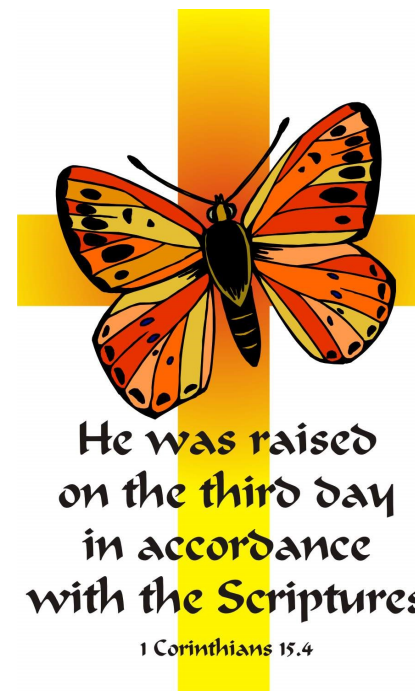

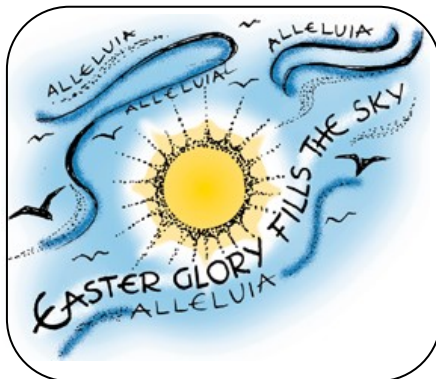
